










Applying to CASA Cuba (tentative)

Brown welcomes all degree-seeking students from four-year, U.S. accredited universities to apply to one of its seven Brown/CASA Global Centers.

Learn more about each phase of your study abroad journey as a visiting student:

Eligibility

- Good academic standing
- Must have declared concentration by the start of your study abroad program
- Must have completed at least fifth semester of Spanish or the equivalent





Student Visas, Money & Communication

- Cuban student visas are arranged by CDLA & Brown; only valid passport copy needed
- Students should plan to bring all money with them in cash for the semester; U.S. credit/debit cards do not work in Cuba
- Internet connectivity isn't always reliable;
 flexibility & planning is key







Health, Safety, & Security

- Cuban local health insurance is provided for all students through ASISTUR and included in the program fee
- Clínica Internacional Cira García is the international health clinic recommended for students; includes emergency, walk-in clinic and pharmacy services
- International SOS
 - Medical, health-related and mental health appointments and emergency medical assistance
